What does the student pass include?

Full Festival Pass

The student pass is a Full Festival Pass. Over 200 films feature in more than 20 competition programmes screened during the week, and the student pass includes access to all competition screenings, (excluding main gala headline events). Students can also access workshops, masterclasses and panel discussions taking place between Wednesday-Saturday.

Big Discounts

The Student Pass secures a 20% discount off main gala events that sit outside the pass, subject to availability.

Booking details and costs

Student Group Passes are priced at £80 per student, minimum group is 10 and this must be booked and paid for before July 1st. For every 10 students booked, a tutor goes free!

Early Bird Discount £65 per student (booked & paid before 31 May)

We offer a flexible booking process where passes can be added during the first week of term.

Terms and Conditions for pass holders:

- The pass alone does not guarantee you entry to screenings/events. Tickets must be pre-booked for each screening/event pass holders wish to attend on the morning of the screening/event
- Pass holders can book only 1 ticket per pass per screening/event
- Please note tickets are limited and therefore subject to availability for each event/screening
- If you are bringing a large group, tickets for certain events may be reserved prior to the festival please contact us with your requests
- Reserved uncollected tickets will go on sale 15 minutes before start time. Please return any unused tickets as these will remain as empty seats if you don't turn up
- Please note that travel and accommodation costs are not included in the packages (we recommend early booking as accommodation fills up early)
